

RE:

In RE children will learn about the idea of a creator and creation. They will explore how creation stories influence people's belief and behaviour. Children will participate by exploring, feeling, touching or discussing in a creation story.

Maths: We are doing lots of number work this term, including place value, multiplication and division and fractions. There will also be lots of practical Maths to help the children learn about money, measure, geometry and data collection.

English: We will be looking at stories from other cultures, report writing, significant authors and writing captions. The children will also be learning phonics/spelling and handwriting on a regular basis.

PE: In PE we will be taking part in dance activities, learning about net/wall games and working on our team working skills. We will have swimming in the second half term.



Science: In Science we will learn about evolution and inheritance. Children will recognise that living things change over time and may become extinct; they will explore some evidence of evolution and inheritance. Children will create their own breeds of dogs and cats and will do a research about inherited features. Children will also learn about plants. They will explore various plants and grow beans.

Computing: In computing the children will be learning about simple programming and digital media, linked to our topic.

PSHE: In PSHE we will be learning about resolving conflicts and growing and changing, which will link to health and well-being.

Topic: Our topic for this term is 'Rainforests' and our work in Art/DT/Geography/History and Music will all be linked to this theme.
