Arrival/Day 1 15th May 2022

The children used the map to lead us from the main quay to the King's Gate.


We walked along the edges of the fortress and saw some cannons on our way.

All too soon it was time for lunch- we had fish fingers or veggie burgers, potatoes and peas. We had to eat quickly and get ourselves sorted as we then were on the coach for a short ride to the sports complex.

At the sports complex we walked through the forest for 1.5 kilometres and arrived at a special camp beside a lake. Andreas lit a fire and we played for a little bit. The older children played on the jetty and some of them got very wet!! When the fire was hot enough, we cooked our own sausages on the fire -we put them on a long wooden stick which Andreas had sharpened with his very sharp knife. It was really smoky but at the end we got to eat our sausages with ketchup! Then we all sat and talked with our friends in the bright sunshine.

Before long it was time to walk back to the coach as we needed to get back to school to do our next job! All the children from the different countries went to work in the Home Economics Rooms to make dinner for the grown ups(who had to go to a meeting!)
