Maths - We shall start the
term developing our skills
in number and place
value, addition
/subtraction, money and
shape. Later in the term
we will revisit number,
and place value, time and
measures, multiplication,
division and fractions.

Home Learning

and our weekly
lessons will include**

RE - We are thinking
about Why Muhammad is
important to Muslims?
During spring to we will
look at the festivals we
celebrate at Spring time.

PSHE - We shall explore
making rules which help
us stay safe and secure. In
the next term we are
exploring healthy exercise
and how we can
implement this into daily
school and home life.

Computing - We will use
computer programmes to
record data we collect.
Using the internet and
different educational
websites, we will look at
communication and
collaboration using IT and
how to be safe online by
exploring e-safety.

Reading - Your child will read at
school at least twice a week. Your
child's book will be changed
every 2 weeks, arrangements for
home learning reading books will
be made apparent soon. Share the
book with your child, reading to
your child is as important as
encouraging them to read the
words themselves, look at the
pictures together and talk about
what they see.

Science - We shall be looking at
electricity, construct circuits,
identify whether bulbs work or
not, use switches and begin to
recognise some common materials
that are conductors. Spring Term
2 will see the children explore
forces and magnets. They will
observe movement including
rolling, falling. We shall notice
forces using magnets.

English - This term we will be
writing instructions, exploring
stories with familiar settings;
including stories about farms and
stories set in homes. We will
enjoy looking at the settings of
stories in fantasy worlds. We will
begin to explore alphabets and
the order of letters of the
alphabet, we will engage in first
alphabet dictionaries.
