Information

Topic – Rainforests



Our topic this term is 'Rainforests', and we are going to be looking at a different aspect of the Rainforest each week, doing lots of practical activities and making some lovely art work for each. They include, the 4 layers of the Rainforest, animals and plants that live in the Rainforest, people who live in the rainforest, and how it is being cut down and destroyed in some places.

English

In English we will continue to work on our phonics and reading skills, and our letter formation and handwriting. We will be looking at and working on stories from other cultures, which will link to our topic. Then later in the term we will be looking a Non-Fiction texts and writing our own reports, and information about Rainforests.

Maths

In Maths this term we will be working on Number, practising our counting and place value for larger numbers. We will also be working on other maths skills including addition, subtraction, measuring weights, capacity, money, telling the time and data handling.

Science

In Science this term, we are learning all about 'Living things: Evolution, Inheritance and Adaptation'. We will be looking at the human skeleton, and other animal skeletons to compare them, as well as looking at how animals change when they grow, and how they adapt to live happily in their habitats.

P.E.

Due to Covid-19 most of our PE lessons will be done in class or outside on the playground or at the local park, we will not have to change into PE kit. If this changes we will let you know!

Computing

We will be using Bee-Bots and on screen programs to input direction commands to move items in given directions. Then later on we will be using equipment to create digital media such as videos, comic strips and start/stop animation.
