**This term our topic is
'Under and Over the Sea' and
our weekly lessons will
include...**

Reading - Your child will read at school at least twice a week. Your **child's** book will be changed every 2 weeks. Share the book with your child, reading to your child is as important as encouraging them to read the words themselves, look at the pictures together and talk about what they see.

PE- We welcome our external PE Coach Juliette to lead a weekly PE session. PE lessons this term will include: Starting blocks, outdoor & adventurous, out and about.

PSHE – We are thinking about 'My family', 'Relationships Rights and choices' and 'Health and well-being'. We will consider our close families, school and wider community, how relationships work, respect for self and others and the importance of responsible behaviours and actions.

Science - We are learning to identify and sort sources of light, exploring how shadows are formed and the terms opaque, transparent and translucent and how light travels and can be split.

Maths - We shall start the term developing our skills in direction and position, money, addition and subtraction then number and place value. The final part of the Summer term will see us working with data, shape and time.

English – This term we will be sharing poetry from other cultures and poems with predictable and patterned language.

RE – This term we are considering 'Peace' by communicating our ideas about religion, life events and experiences. We are sharing our thoughts and feelings on what is special to us. We will look at ways to experience peace through relaxation and sensory experiences.

Home Learning Activities – A summer pack will be set for you to try and complete activities each week and is an opportunity for you to share with school by making comments, sending in photographs or emailing via the school.

We will explore myths and legends through fables and folk tales. We will use instructions to make and do things and follow recipes to bake. We will engage in drama where we can act, move and follow scripts.

Computing – We will use IT-Digital media to explore Graphics and use online research to find out about things found under and over the sea. We will explore programming using Beebots and other programmable equipment.
