Homework - will continue to be sent via Teams and should be sent back by the following Thursday evening. Your child should be able to complete this independently and it usually follows the week's theme in either English, Maths or Science.

Use the **home-school book** for us to share information. Please check it each evening just in case there are letters / information. Feel free to pop anything in there that you think we need to know. We check them every morning at school. If you wish to contact me by 'phone please feel free - you may have to leave a message but I will call you back.

Please send in **spare clothing** if you feel your child may need this. We will keep it safely at school and inform you of any accidents.

Morning snack and lunch is being eaten in a classroom - thank you for sending in snacks, drinks and lunches. Kingswood are able to provide lunches, which you can order in the usual way. If your child needs any cutlery - including a cup - please send them in with your child.

Please remember, if your child is unwell please follow the guidelines that you have been sent by the school.
